1945	Franklin Roosevelt attends Yalta Conference
July 1945	Truman meets with Stalin in Germany
January 20, 1953	Dwight D. Eisenhower elected president
June 1954	CIA organizes overthrow of democratically elected government of Guatemala
January 1, 1959	Cuban Revolution
July 1959	Nixon visits USSR to open the American Exhibition in Moscow
September 14, 1959	Soviet rockets hits the moon
Sept 15-28, 1959	<u>Khrushchev's 13 day US tour</u>
January 20 1960	Kennedy inaugurated as President
May 1, 1960	Gary Powers shot down in U-2 spy plane
May 14, 1960	Paris Summit opened
September 1960	Khrushchev to UN (restricted to NY due to death threats)
April 15, 1961	Bay of Pigs
April 1961	Soviet Cosmonaut becomes first to orbit the earth
May 25, 1961	Kennedy calls for 3fold increase in spending for fall out shelters
June 3, 1961	<u>Khrushchev and Kennedy meet in Vienna</u>
July 1961	Khrushchev cancels plans to reduce size of Soviet Army
July 1961	Kennedy calls for increased military spending and recommends bomb shelters
Aug 1961	Soviets begin building the Berlin Wall
October 1962	<u>Cuban Missile Crisis</u>
